

GLIMPSES OF 2nd CIRCLE COUNCIL

2nd Circle Council of Gujarat Circle was held on 03.04.2010 at Conference Room, 11th Floor, Circle Office, Ahmedabad.

The following Items were discussed for DR-TTAs:

ISSUE	COMPLIANCE
DR-TTAs must be given all the Trainings of New Technology.	Management agreed fully and ensure that guidelines are already issued to all districts in this respect.
Broadband facility should be given to TTAs in office.	CGM told that it is under purview of respective GMs. They may approve the same case by case.
Regarding the letter issued by C.O. no. BBS/Genl/08-09/Vol-I/105 dated 01.12.2009 about issuing Laptop to DR-TTAs posted as OC-LAN in charge. We represented that Laptop should be issued to the TTAs handling Broadband Outdoor Faults and not just OC-LAN in charges.	After long discussions Management agreed to revise the instructions accordingly. They informed that TENDER for purchasing Laptops is under process.
In case of RULE-8 transfer of TTAs, at present if application is forwarded with the remarks "With Substitute" are sent back to SSA and no wait list is maintained at Circle Office. We represented that the wait list should be maintained at Circle Office and as and when possible these transfers may be done.	After much discussion, management agreed to maintain Wait List at Circle Office. Also they clarified that if remark is "Without Substitute", the orders are issued with no delay.
We strongly represented about our issue of irregularities in EPF deductions. We requested to display our deductions to us on monthly basis.	Management agreed to look in to the matter positively and also considering our demand they assured to check the feasibility of displaying both contributions in our PAY SLIPS.
We discussed about GSM service Connection to TTAs.	The issue was sent to Corporate Office and clarification received that it is not in power of Circle Office and it is in consideration at Corporate Office on all India basis. We demanded that at least a CUG Group may be formed in Gujarat in which all non executives may enter free of cost with their personal prepaid no and they may call free in CUG. Management agreed to look in to the matter and it will be done if feasible.

In general, CGM taken all our issues positively and ensure his concern to DR-TTAs with his high expectations from us.

We represented that if we work hard, efficiently and beyond our purview then we also need proper appreciation at all levels from CGM to SDE...
